Rubber and pencil sharpener.

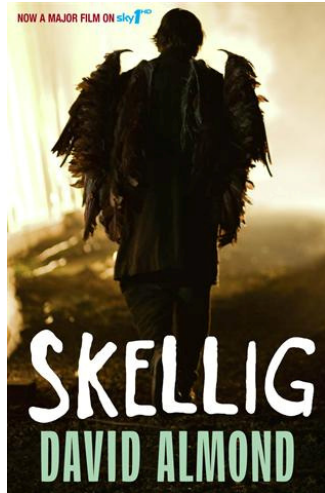


These items should be replenished on a regular basis, ideally half termly.
