We have obtained advice from the Health Protection Agency regarding E.coli infection. Please note that:

Any pupil with confirmed E.coli O157 infection must not come to school.

Those over 5 years old can return to school once they have been symptom free for 48 hours.

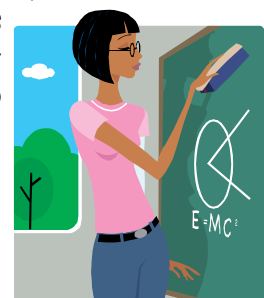
Children under 5 must be tested and proved negative before returning to school. This will be organised by the Health Protection Agency.

In addition, please remember that any child with symptoms of diarrhoea and vomiting should not return to school until 48 hours after their symptoms have resolved.

School Office

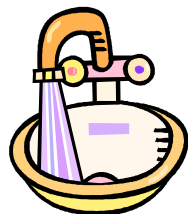
