Tuesday 14th November—Carols and mulled wine in the front hall from 3.30p.m. School finishes at 4.00p.m.

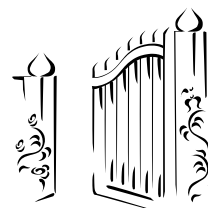
Christmas Fayre—Saturday 4th December-11.00-1.00p.m.
