### Extras

### Support level fees

For the benefit of our dyslexic pupils, the whole of the school's operations are structured with the view to being "dyslexia friendly". In addition to specialist English teachers, our Maths, Science, IT, DT and Art lessons are taught by teachers with specialist dyslexia qualifications or have the course designed to be "dyslexia friendly". Almost all of our teachers, including mainstream teachers, have received instruction in the needs of dyslexic pupils.

The teaching methods we have introduced for our dyslexic pupils benefit all pupils, not only dyslexic ones. This is evident, for example, in the advance in literacy and numeracy scores being achieved by mainstream pupils in nationally standardised tests and in the teaching of "touch typing" to all pupils at an early age.

Since no two children have exactly the same needs, we specialise in providing a bespoke programme of educational support to our pupils which we adapt as they progress and their needs change. Some pupils need only limited support but experience has shown us that they will get better benefit from this after a period of more intensive support.

Our entry level support fee covers specialist teaching or support in small groups in English or Maths, or the support of an additional teaching assistant in the classroom for other subjects.

Full dyslexia support is usually provided in small specialist classes with intensive work on literacy and numeracy skills and will usually include some one to one lessons.

Occupational Therapy and Speech and Language Therapy are available as extras. The fees for a Speech and Language assessment and for an Occupational Therapy Assessment are £295 each. Therapy fees for both are based on a rate of £65 per hour to include time taken in the preparation of reports and related administration. If a programme of therapy is recommended, you will be advised of the time and cost involved.

Additional one to one lessons are also available as an extra.

### **Assessment Fee prior to admission**

It is important for the school and its pupils that we admit pupils who we believe will benefit from our methods of education. This means that we need to conduct a careful assessment of the child's abilities and needs during the course of a day at the school. This will also provide an opportunity for us to see how the child fits in with our other pupils and for the child to decide whether this is a school he or she would like to attend.

The fee for this assessment is £150 payable in advance. If as a result of the visit and assessment a place is offered and accepted, half of that fee (£75) will be credited to offset the Registration fee of £75.

### **Registration and Deposit**

A non refundable registration fee of £75 is payable on registration and a deposit £350 is payable on acceptance of a place. The deposit is refundable after the last term has been completed, subject to payment of all outstanding accounts.
